As you donate to relief funds in the wake of Hurricane Harvey, **be careful where you send your support.** There have been reports of cybercriminals exploiting the Hurricane Harvey disaster by **soliciting donations through fake Facebook pages, tweets, texts and emails.** Rather than using the money for good, these criminals keep the money for themselves.
